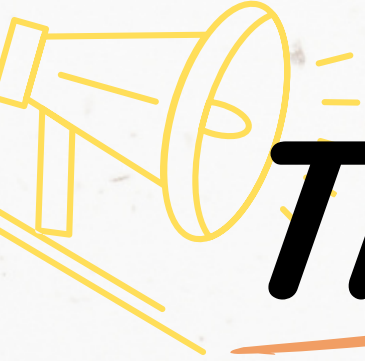

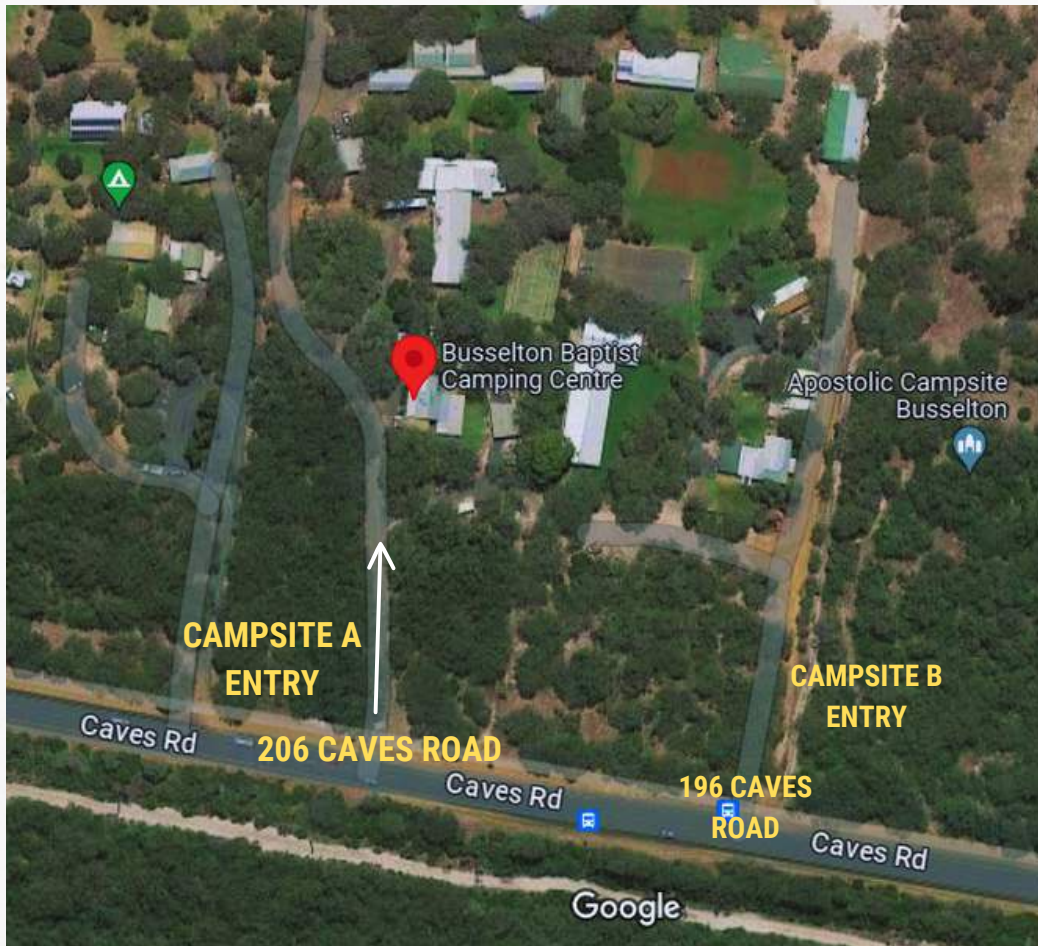

LOCATION

Busselton Baptist Camping Centre is located in **206 Caves Road, Siesta Park, Busselton WA 6280**. There are two campsites - Campsite A and Campsite B - we will be located in **Campsite A**. The campsite is situated on the beachfront land between Busselton and Dunsborough; entrance to the campsite is alongside Caves Road.

ACCOMODATION & FACILITIES

The campsite is provided with multiple dorms, showers, toilets, a meeting hall, dining hall, kitchen, a tennis court and a BBQ. Families will be allocated a room together and single campers will be allocated to a room with other single campers. Male and female single campers will be allocated separate dorms.

Upon registration, you are able to choose the group of people you wish to share a room with and Camp Organisers will try to accommodate your wishes as best as they can.

Are children under 18 years old allowed to attend by themselves?

If a child under 18 years old is attending without their parents or a legal guardian, then we require a signed permission slip from their parents/legal guardian. Permission slips can be returned to their respective Battlefield Youth Leader or emailed to homecitychurch.aus@gmail.com. After confirmation, they can register online. Transport is not provided and will have to be organised independently.
